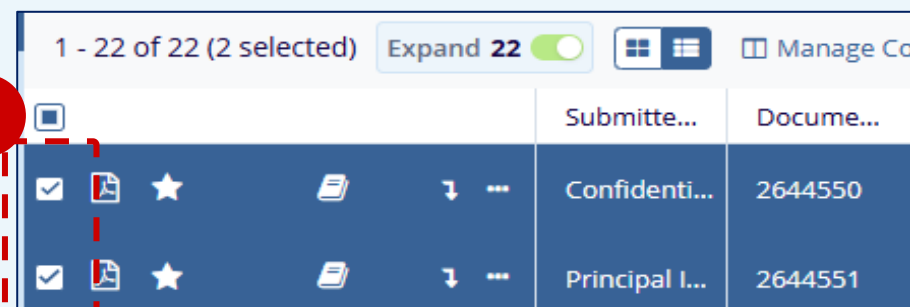

Locate the document(s) to be copied.



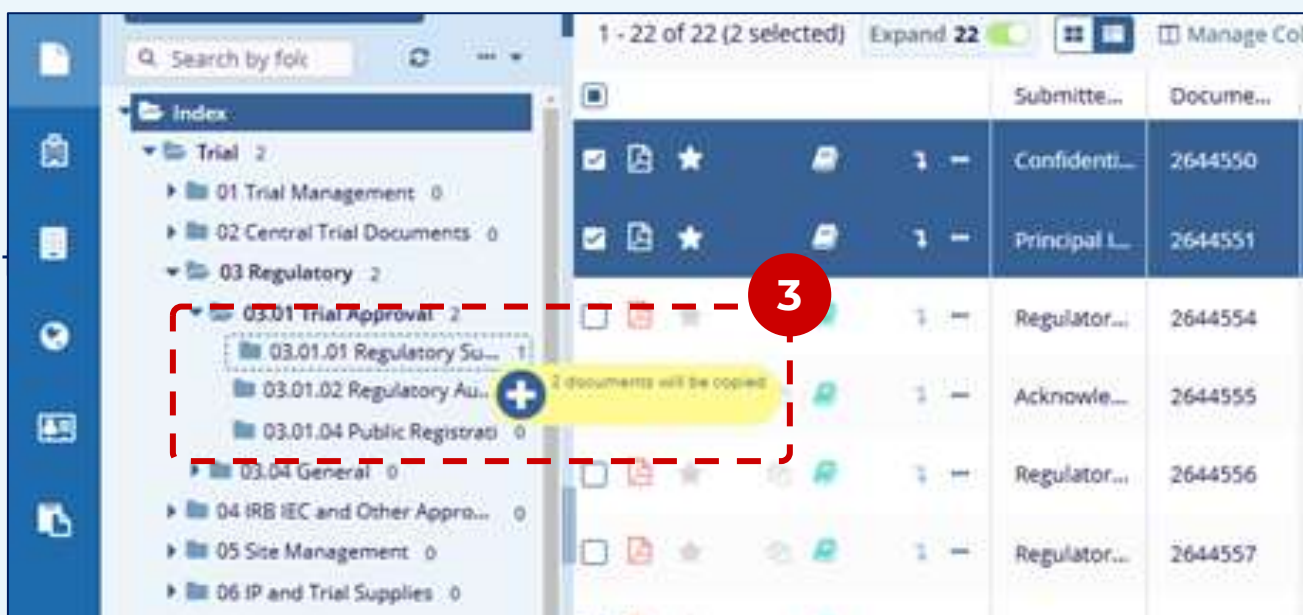

Check the box next to each document to select multiple items.

Click and drag the documents to their destination folder. Keep the **Ctrl** button (**Command** on Mac) pressed while doing so. The yellow tooltip will confirm that documents are going to be copied.

Release the mouse button to finalize copying the files to the target folder. Success!
